Serving on the Board

The Board is responsible for the governance of the District. Its powers and duties include the broad authority to adopt and enforce all necessary policies for the management and governance of East Alton - Wood River Community High School.

The Board of Education is composed of seven citizens elected to serve overlapping terms of four years each. At the end of a term, a Board member wishing to continue service must be re-elected for an additional four-year term. There is no limit to the number of terms to which a member may be elected. Members are elected on an “at-large” basis.

Election of school board members takes place on the 1st Tuesday in April in an odd-numbered year. The next Board election will be held in April of 2019.

Board Meetings—How They Work

The Board of Education meets regularly on the 1st and 2nd Tuesdays of the month in the Conference Room at EAWR. The 1st Regular Tuesday Meeting is generally a discussion and review meeting, although some action items are scheduled as needed. Most school board business and action items are reserved for the 2nd Tuesday meeting which is the Board’s Regular Meeting. All meetings are called to order at 6:00 PM.

- The President has the authority to determine procedural matters not otherwise defined by Board Policy.
