What follows is an unofficial summary of the East Alton - Wood River Community High School District #14 Board of Education Regular Meeting of September 12, 2017.

FY 2018 Budget Hearing

Dr. Pearson briefly reviewed the highlights of the budget, with no changes in the proposed budget numbers since the Regular September 12, 2017 Meeting.

He also noted that the tentative version of the FY 18 budget has been on display for more than the required 30 days, with this budget hearing duly noticed in the Telegraph.

President Murray noted, for the record, that there were no comments from the public, since no audience was in attendance.

The Board approved a motion adopting the FY 2018 District Budget, as presented.

Approve Intergovernmental Agreement with City of Wood River

Supt. Pearson reviewed the essential elements again of the proposed Intergovernmental Agreement with City of Wood River, which would allow the school district to receive 5% of any future proceeds of the TIF-#2 extension, over and above the minimum threshold amount that the City needs for its renovation of the sewage treatment plant. That was the rationale the City is using for seeking the 12-Year Extension of TIF-#2 from the General Assembly.

The Board adopted the Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Wood River regarding the proposed 12-Year extension of TIF-#2.
