WHEN: FEBRUARY 4, 2016

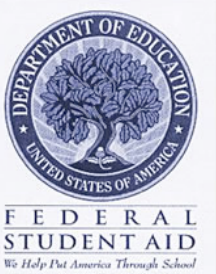
WHERE: EAST ALTON-WOOD RIVER AUDITORIUM – MAIN BUILDING
